Today you are having a picnic, but first you have to run to the store and pick up a few things. You have made a list but you need to find out how much money you should bring. Multiply the amounts of each item by its unit price, then add them together to get a total.

Example:

Shopping List
2 pears
3 milks
1 plum

\$0.30	\$2.45	\$0.54	.60
<u> x 2</u>	<u> x 3</u>	<u> x 1</u>	7.35
\$0.60	\$7.35	\$0.54	<u> + .54</u>
Cost of Pears	Cost of Milk	Cost of a Plum	Total = \$8.49
